Award Information

Society of Manufacturing Engineers, Nashville Chapter #43 is offering funds to its current membership and their families as well as active members of student chapter #S239 (MTSU), #S215 (TTU), #S252 (APSU), TCAT S369 and other engineering students as selected by the committee. A total of \$10,000 will be disbursed as awards to qualifying persons for the school year. There will be five (5) awards of \$1,500 each for college degree and five (5) awards of \$500 each for technical college that will be available this year.

EDUCATION PURPOSES

The money shall be used for education in a manufacturing curriculum.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

1. Status of applicant.
 - a) Member of Nashville Chapter #43
Or
 - b) Legal relative of Chapter #43 member (e.g.; son, daughter, grandchild, nephew or niece.
Or
 - c) Member of Student chapter #S239 (MTSU) or #S252 (APSU) or #S215 (TTU) or S369 TCAT Hartsville or other student SME members
 - d) Other engineering students as selected by the committee
2. The appropriateness of the educational program relative to the purpose of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers.
3. Minimum 3.0 GPA (on a 4-point scale) accumulative for the last two semesters.
4. The applicant must be a full time student (12 credit hours minimum) or for technical schools 180 clock hours per trimester.
5. The applicant must have completed a minimum of one semester of post high school education

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. An application form must be filed on or before May 31, with the committee of SME Nashville Chapter #43.
2. The applicant will be notified in writing of the committee decision related to his/her application by July 15.
3. The funds will go to the financial aid office of the appropriate educational institution to be allocated for tuition only.
4. If awarded funds, the applicant agrees to furnish a recent photo to be posted on our web site and to participate in any awards ceremonies as scheduled by the SME chapter(s) and/or the appropriate educational institution.
